The big reveal


Sealed behind a metal door for 40 years, this hilltop palazzo in Umbria was forgotten and unloved, until one intrepid architect chose to step inside

Kitchen Finished in a combination of white lacquer and stainless steel, this cabinetry from Gruppo Euro-nobil adds a contemporary edge to the space's rustic charm. **Opposite, clockwise from top left** The original winding staircase. The bathroom, which features twin custom-made marble basins, taps by Rubinetterie Treemme and a laminated yellow screen (designed as a nod to the coloured glass at the entrance to this room). A seating area in the main bedroom, where a 'Ghost' chaise longue by Paola Navone for Gervasoni sits beside a 'Fat-Fat' side table by Patricia Urquiola for B&B Italia, beneath a '265' wall light by Paolo Rizzatto for Flos and a trio of art works by Russell Marshall ►
